It's time to prepare for flu season, which typically runs October through May. The CDC and American Academy of Pediatrics recommend a flu shot for all children without medical contraindications who are over 6 months old. A flu shot is the easiest and most effective way to protect your family from the flu. Not only can a flu shot help prevent infection, it also helps lessen the severity of flu symptoms if you do become sick. Preventing serious illness from flu with a vaccine helps ensure our local hospitals have the resources they need to care for the community during flu season and the COVID pandemic.
